

RESOLUTION OF THE CALL FOR ART, SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIETY RESIDENCE

On December 21, 2023, the Art, Science, Technology and Society residence call was published on Tabakalera's website through the art department with the aim of promoting artistic projects that seek to interact with the fields of science and technology.

In compliance with that stipulated in section 4 of the aforementioned Terms and Conditions, a Commission was constituted between the University of the Basque Country (Edurne González and Natxo Rodríguez) and Tabakalera (Ane Agirre, Laida Mendia and Ibai Zabaleta) to evaluate the projects presented.

The Commission having evaluated the projects presented on time and in compliance with the criteria established in the Terms and Conditions for selecting projects opting for the residence, as proposed by the aforementioned Commission, the Managing Director of CICC/Tabakalera

HAS DECIDED TO

One.- Select the projects presented by the individuals listed on the table included as Annex I to participate in the Art, Science, Technology and Society residence according to the terms included in the Terms and Conditions thereof.

Two.- Provide the following to each of the projects selected:

- 1) Travel and accommodation:
 - a) If the candidate is not a resident in the BAC:
 - i) Return ticket from the artist's place of residence or from the place where the artist is located immediately prior to the residency, at the discretion of the successful applicant.
 - ii) Double room for single use with a bathroom, small work area, and Wi-Fi; shared access to a kitchen and living room. Access to this communal area may be regulated by the rules of use established by the centre.
 - b) If the candidate is a resident in the BAC:
 - i) Travel to and from their place of residence in the BAC. If the candidate resides outside the city of San Sebastian or the surrounding area, he or she may benefit from accommodation with the aforementioned characteristics or a maximum of €500 per month of the residency for transport costs.
- 2) Medical insurance during the residency period should the candidate not be a European resident.
- 3) €1,000 net per month of the residency, for per diem and living expenses, to be paid as a cheque payable in the name of the bearer. A withholding tax will be levied on this amount depending on the tax status of each resident. For this purpose, the corresponding documentation will be requested (form 036 for residents in Spain, and a tax residence certificate for residents abroad).
- 4) Workspace equipped with basic furniture, electrical outlets, and lighting within Tabakalera's artists' space as well as Wi-Fi internet access. The studio will be assigned taking into account the characteristics of the selected project.
- 5) Access to the office and communal areas.
- 6) Access to all Tabakalera resources, to Tabakalera's specialised creation library, and to Medialab's resources.
- 7) Access to image and sound editing studios, a performing arts practice space or set, and audiovisual resources on loan.
- 8) Technical resources and assistance from the Tabakalera team, as needed and when available.
- 9) Allocation of additional financial support, up to a maximum of €1,500, upon submission of a budget and approval by Tabakalera, to cover minor expenses related to the production process, which must be used for the production and will not cover the acquisition of technological equipment or bibliographic materials. The amount designated for production will be managed by the Tabakalera



personnel assigned for this purpose. Tabakalera will not pay for any expenses incurred without prior consultation and approval by the team assigned for this purpose. The resident may use up to a maximum of €500 of the total budget (€1500) for his or her own fees upon submission of an invoice by the corresponding deadline. In this case, they must comply with the requirements of the legislation in force at the time the results of the call are announced.

10) Conceptual and artistic guidance in developing the project, as well as help with introducing it to agents in the scientific and technological field with whom Tabakalera collaborates.

Three.- Publish this Resolution on the website of the Centro Internacional de Cultura Contemporánea, S.A. and provide notice thereof to those selected.
