



## RESOLUTION OF THE CALL FOR SPATIAL AFFAIRS 2024

On March 24th, the SPATIAL AFFAIRS announcement of grants was published on Tabakalera's website with the aim of promoting proposals to develop prototypes for performances in physical space that interweaves body, space, technology in synergetic ways to foster collective lived experiences.

**Two.-** Offer a residence with the characteristics indicated in No. 2 of the bases to each of the selected projects.

**Three.-** Publish this Resolution on the website of the Centro Internacional de Cultura Contemporánea, S.A. and provide notice thereof to those selected.
