FINAL RESULT OF THE JAI 2024 STUDIES PROGRAMME OPEN CALL

On 29 April, the committee for the JAI Studies Programme (Institute of Artistic Practices) met to select the group of 16 participants that will take part in its 2024 edition.

The selection includes the awarding of four grants for registration (€400) and maintenance expenses (€900).

Likewise, the committee proceeded to select the 5 alternate candidates in case any of the participants report that they are unable to take part.

Fifty candidates presented submissions for the call.

The selection criteria for this call were:

- 1- Interest and quality of the work presented in the dossier.
- 2- Suitability of the objectives stated by the candidates in their presentation in terms of the study programme's lines of work.

The selection process completed responds to the criteria of parity and creating a pluralistic, diverse group in terms of various parameters that ultimately determine the selected group's composition:

- Geographic origins of the participants, balanced between local and non-local participants.
- Intergenerational confluence, including professionals with diverse career paths and ages.
- Plurality of languages and disciplines present in the practice of contemporary art.
