



## RESOLUTION OF THE CALL FOR RESIDENCY: CCA-HOSPITALFIELD

On August 5th of 2024, the residency: CCA-Hospitalfield announcement of grants was published on Tabakalera's website through the contemporary art department with the aim of creating a collaboration with the Etxepare Institute and Tabakalera-International Center for Contemporary Culture. The objective of this collaboration is to promote a residency program in exchange with CCA: Centre of Contemporary Arts and Hospitalfield.

In compliance with that stipulated in section 4 of the aforementioned Terms and Conditions, a Commission was constituted consisting of Ane Agirre (Tabakalera), Nagore Olarra (Tabakalera), Cicely Farrer (Hospitalfield) and Alex Misick (CCA) to assess the two Parts that comprise the Open Call.

The Commission having evaluated the projects presented on time and in compliance with the criteria established in the Terms and Conditions for selecting projects opting for residency, as proposed by the aforementioned Commission, the Managing Director of CICC/Tabakalera

### HAS DECIDED TO

**One.-** Select the projects presented by the individuals listed on the table included as Annex I to participate in residency: CCA-Hospitalfield of the Open Call according to the terms included in the Terms and Conditions thereof.

**Two.-** Provide the following to the project selected:

1. Round trip for the selected person, from the Basque Country to Scotland. The residency will cover the costs of the following trips:
  - a. Place of residence – Glasgow
  - b. Glasgow – Arbroath
  - c. Arbroath – Scottish airport
  - d. Scottish airport – Place of residence
2. At Hospitalfield: The artist resident will stay in the historic house and be allocated work space based on their studio requirements and research interests. They will be part of a group residency of 8 other artists who will be individually developing their own projects. Residents have their meals catered for by the in-house chef based on dietary requirements submitted in advance of the residency. The artist will have a private bedroom, shared bathroom and access to a shared kitchen as well as internet through Wi-Fi throughout the House.
3. At CCA In Glasgow: A fully equipped apartment (kitchen, bathroom and bedroom with a small area for working, access to the internet with Wi-Fi). A work space equipped with the basic furniture, lighting, electricity and Wi-Fi.
4. 1,250€ (excluding taxes and deductions) as allowance for living and working for the whole period of the residency, to be paid by invoice.



5. Financial resources up to a maximum of 500€ (excluding taxes and deductions), to be paid by invoice.
6. Conceptual assistance with the development of the project as well as assistance and help in introducing it to different agents and projects in the same context, if required by the resident.

**Three.-** Publish this Resolution on the website of the Centro Internacional de Cultura Contemporánea, S.A. and provide notice thereof to those selected.
